If you see something totally new and unique that appeals to you, it's going to have that same effect on buyers in your niche. I think Mike on American Picker's put it best, "In my business if you come across something you've never seen before the best time to buy it is now." If you don't have that gut instinct to recognize something good—it's going to be harder to be successful on eBay. Here's why? If you don't have that gut instinct to recognize what's good and what's not, it's going to be like walking into a room with blinders on. There may be fifty items that will allow you to double or triple your money, but you're likely to miss every single one of them, because you are laser focused on just a few items you're comfortable selling. That's good for the guy behind you. He's going to grab everything you walked by, and he's going to be able to pay his bills this week. But it sucks for you. You're going to be right back to thinking eBay is a scam, and there's no way anyone's making any money on the site. It happens every day. Don't believe me?
