First published in 1943, *The Little Prince* by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry has been translated into more than 250 languages, becoming a global phenomenon. The Sahara desert is the scenery of *Little Prince's* story. The narrator's plane has

crashed there and he has scarcely some food and water to survive. Trying to comprehend what caused the crash, the Little Prince appears. The serious blonde little boy asks to draw him a sheep. The narrator consents to the strange fellow's request. They soon become friends and the Little Prince informs the pilot that he is from a small planet, the asteroid 325, talks to him about the baobabs, his planet volcanoes and the mysterious rose that grew on his planet. He also talks to him about their friendship and the lie that evoked his journey to other planets. Often puzzled by the grown-ups' behavior, the little traveler becomes a total and eternal symbol of innocence and love, of responsibility and devotion. Through him we get to see how insightful children are and how grown-ups aren't. Children use their heart to feel what's really important, not the eyes. Heart-breaking, funny and thought-provoking, it is an enchanting and endlessly wise fable about the human condition and the power of imagination. A book about both childhood and adulthood, it can be read as a parable, a war story, a classic children's fairy-tale, and many more things besides: The Little Prince is a book for everyone; after all, all grown-ups were children once.

Questo volume prende in esame la parabola letteraria di Elsa Morante mirando a coniugare filologia e teoria della letteratura. L'indagine di alcuni materiali giovanili conservati nell'Archivio Morante presso la Biblioteca centrale nazionale di Roma costituisce il punto di partenza per un'interpretazione del lavoro della scrittrice che si basa sull'interazione dei concetti critici di memoria poetica e modo narrativo. La continua riproposizione di immagini, oggetti, motivi, temi dalla giovinezza alla maturità mostra infatti come sia attiva in Morante una memoria del fare letterario che si sviluppa in riprese variate di un immaginario modulare; al contempo, il transitare nei testi di costanti e varianti si distribuisce in una formazione di compromesso fra i modi del romance e del novel che è la più intima cifra della scrittura dell'autrice. Pagina dopo pagina, emerge così una Morante svincolata da vari cliché critico-biografici che hanno limitato il riconoscimento della sua consapevolezza metaletteraria, e intenta, piuttosto, a sperimentare in un autentico 'laboratorio della finzione' nuovi percorsi del romanzo novecentesco.

They came from the poorest parts of Ireland and Italy and met as rivals on the sidewalks of New York. Beginning in the nineteenth century, the Irish and Italians clashed in the Catholic Church, on the waterfront, at construction sites, and in the streets. Then they made peace through romance, marrying each other on a large scale in the years after World War II. An Unlikely Union tells the dramatic story of how two of America's largest ethnic groups learned to love and laugh with each other after decades of animosity. The vibrant cast of characters features saints such as Mother Frances X. Cabrini, who stood up to the Irish American archbishop of New York when he tried to send her back to Italy, and sinners like Al Capone, who left his Irish wife home the night he shot it out with Brooklyn's Irish mob. The book also highlights the torrid love affair between radical labor

organizers Elizabeth Gurley Flynn and Carlo Tresca; the alliance between Italian American gangster Paul Kelly and Tammany's "Big Tim" Sullivan; heroic detective Joseph Petrosino's struggle to be accepted in the Irish-run NYPD; and the competition between Frank Sinatra and Bing Crosby to become the country's top male vocalist. In this engaging history of the Irish and Italians, veteran New York City journalist and professor Paul Moses offers a classic American story of competition, cooperation, and resilience. At a time of renewed fear of immigrants, *An Unlikely Union* reminds us that Americans are able to absorb tremendous social change and conflict—and come out the better for it.

This book concerns the relationship between ideas and power in the genesis of the Roman empire. The self-justification of the first emperor through the consensus of the citizen body constrained him to adhere to 'legitimate' and 'traditional' forms of self-presentation. Lobur explores how these notions become explicated and reconfigured by the upper and mostly non-political classes of Italy and Rome. The chronic turmoil experienced in the late republic shaped the values and program of the imperial system; it molded the comprehensive and authoritative accounts of Roman tradition and history in a way that allowed the system to appear both traditional and historical. This book also examines how shifts in rhetorical and historiographical practices facilitated the spreading and assimilation of shared ideas that allowed the empire to cohere.

In questo tomo, dal significativo titolo *Enciclopedia dei Poeti Italiani Contemporanei*, sono state raccolte alcune voci poetiche odierne, non certo con l'intento di circoscrivere un ambito così vasto come quello della poesia al giorno d'oggi, essendo ormai chiaro a tutti il superamento dell'ottimistico presupposto scientifico di ordinare il mondo, di stampo illuministico (periodo in cui l'enciclopedia divenne lo strumento prescelto per la diffusione del sapere, con la pubblicazione dell'*Encyclopédie, ou Dictionnaire raisonné des sciences, des arts et des métiers*). Anche l'origine etimologica della parola *Enciclopedia*, che deriva dall'espressione di Plutarco *enkyklos paideia*, ovvero "istruzione circolare", rimanda ad una classificazione del sapere umano. Ritornando al nostro caso specifico, invece, il volume si presenta non come un'opera esaustiva (impossibile, come sopra accennato) ma come uno strumento di consultazione che porta all'attenzione del pubblico un approfondimento su uno scorcio dell'attuale realtà poetica, quale quella rappresentata dagli autori prescelti. Di tutti loro non sono riportati soltanto i versi, ma anche un profilo individuale con una nota biografica contenente le informazioni sull'attività poetica. Oltre che per il loro valore artistico, i dati raccolti potranno rivelarsi preziosi agli occhi di chi, leggendo bene tra le righe, troverà utile la consultazione di questo materiale anche dal punto di vista antropologico per tracciare un ritratto delle caratteristiche della nostra società in questo specifico momento storico.
